1. Complete the health self-assessment prior to leaving your home.
2. Parents or their designated responsible person must correctly wear a mask while at the bus stop.
3. Following directions will allow you to remain safe, respectful and responsible.
4. Be visible - waiting at your school bus stop. Sitting in vehicles or standing inside houses may cause you not to be seen by the bus team. Remember to stand on the sidewalk or the edge of the street by the curb, avoid standing on private property, be watchful of traffic, stay out of the street and never talk to anyone you do not know.
5. The Three Card System is designed for the protection of students, and to ensure the appropriate, secure transfer of pre-school and kindergarten students from the school bus. Did you know that every Parent of pre-school and kindergarten students are given 3 yellow cards by their child's school? They must present the card every day when picking up their child from the bus and the card must match the information on the child's tag. Student's whose parent does not present a proper card will be returned to school. For more information please see Rights and Responsibilities Handbook, page 9.
